DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your state or tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

The presence of slugs and snails can be detected by their shiny mucous trail. They are night feeders and prefer cool, damp places. They are often found hiding in the lawn.

Apply as a soil surface treatment. Do not mix with any seeds prior to application.

ORNAMENTALS & LAWNS: Ornamental plantings including trees, shrubs, and perennial flowers, ground covers, dichondra, lawns and around building foundations: Scatter bait uniformly at 1 lb. per 2,200 – 4,400 sq. ft., approx. 5 – 12 pellets per square foot (see table below). Repeat treatment as necessary to maintain control. DO NOT place pellets in piles (see picture below).

5 – 12 Pellets / sq. ft. = 3.6-7.2 oz/1000 sq. ft.
5 – 12 Pellets / sq. ft. = 1/2-1 cup/1000 sq. ft.
5 – 12 Pellets / sq. ft. = 1-2 lb./4400 sq. ft.
5 – 12 Pellets / sq. ft. = 10-20 lbs./acre

Apply this product in areas likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs and as needed during periods of damp weather. May be used as a perimeter treatment to prevent invasion of slugs and snails from neighboring properties. For best results, apply in evening. Especially beneficial if applied following rain or watering since slugs and snails will not crawl over dry soil. Apply every 3 to 4 weeks during growing season, or as needed.

Prior experience has shown most plants are not sensitive to Deadline T&O. However, for extremely tender plants such as orchids, it is suggested to do a small test application to determine any plant sensitivity before making a broadcast application over plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Use product only from original container & keep in locked storage away from children and pets. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Dispose of any spills or piles that may occur. Do not leave excess product at application sites.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
