

Bibliography of Neotropical Trichoptera

This bibliography includes references to original citations and important taxonomic or nomenclatural works on the Neotropical Trichoptera fauna, including all the recent and important literature published after 1960. However, the extensive bibliographies presented by Fischer (*Trichopterorum Catalogus*, 1960-1973a) for the literature prior to 1961 are not repeated here if not of primary importance. The reader is referred to Fischer's catalog for this additional literature.

This bibliography includes all literature published through the end of 1998, but includes works also published in 1999. The most recent bibliographic sources checked when compiling this bibliography were *Braueria* (Trichoptera Newsletter), Volume 26, and a prepublication copy of the Trichoptera section of *Current and Selected Bibliographies on Benthic Biology 1998(1999)* of the North American Benthological Society provided to us by A.P. Nimmo. The user should check the appropriate bibliographic sources to ensure complete coverage.
